

ADJOURNED MEETING COUNCIL CHAMBERS WASHINGTON, KANSAS OCTOBER 15, 2001

The Governing Body of the City of Washington met in Adjourned Session in the usual meeting place in said City on Monday the 15th day of October at 7:00 P.M. with the following members present; Mayor Herbert C. Dyck, Council members; Dawn Kramer, Jon Snapp, Kevin Williams, Greg Wilson.

Mayor Dyck called the adjourned meeting to order.

Reviewed Resolution 2001-4 which set a hearing date for October 15th at 7:00 P.M. After discussion from property owner Yvonne Smith and the council Greg Wilson moved to adopt Resolution 2001-7 granting the Smith's until December 3, 2001 to be in compliance with criteria set by Resolution 2001-7. Jon Snapp seconded the motion. Motion carried by all present.

Tim described the property at 101 East 1st as being uninhabitable and not livable. Expense of repair would far exceed value of the property. Pictures were shown to all council members present.

Thereupon Dawn Kramer moved to adopt Resolution 2001-8

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-8

DEEMING AND DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO HOLD A HEARING TO DETERMINE IF A CERTAIN BUILDING HEREIN DESCRIBED IS IN A DANGEROUS AND UNSAFE CONDITION

Thereupon Dawn Kramer moved to adopt Resolution 2001-8 holding a hearing on December 3rd 2001 at 7:15 P.M. for owners and lienholders of record. Thereupon Kevin Williams seconded the motion. Motion was declared carried by all present.

Tim showed pictures of the property in Resolution 2001-5. The owner did not come to the council meeting. Repairs would exceed the value of the property. Thereupon Jon Snapp moved to adopt Resolution 2001-9 giving the owner 90 days from October 15 to demolish and remove and fill in the basement to the natural terrain of property or the City will. Greg Wilson seconded the motion. Motion was declared carried by all present

Tim passed around a card for connecting to City utilities. The card will require SS #, date of birth, driver's license #, State, Phone #, place of employment, service address, mailing address, previous address, landlord's name, deposit amount and connect fee and signature and date. Thereupon Greg Wilson moved to require all applicants to fill in the card for utilities service with the City. Kevin Williams seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Terry Kearn was in about Resolution No. 2001-6 for property at 122 East 4th. The council determined that the porch should be fixed, the house painted, the vegetation should be cleaned up, the garage fixed or demolished, the foundation fixed and the siding fixed, with repairs done by December 3, 2001. Thereupon Greg Wilson moved to adopt Resolution 2001-10. Kevin Williams seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Brandi Sawin was in to visit with the council about Beautification of the Island on "C" between College and 1st Street. Brandi is working on her Girl Scout gold Award and would use this for your community service project. Help from the City would be barricade streets, level the dirt, assisting planting of trees,

if they have any extra weed barrier fabric would they donate it to this project, provide and deliver wood chips. She will need money for the purchase of plants or trees, tulip bulbs and iris roots. The council thanked Brandi for her attending the council meeting and approved of her plans and will help her. Greg Wilson moved the City underwrite this project for \$1,714.00 and accept donation to the city, tax deductible. Thereupon Dawn Kramer seconded the motion. Motion carried by all present.

Mary Leck sent a letter to the Council resigning as director of the Washington EMS, effective immediately. She will continue to serve as EMT-I for the service and take regular call time. Jon Snapp moved to accept Mary Lecks resignation. Greg Wilson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Greg Wilson moved to give the day after Thanksgiving off to all employees. Kevin Williams seconded the motion. Motion carried.
