The Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas met in Adjourned Session in the usual meeting place in said City on Monday the 13th day of August at 7:00 P.M. with the following members present; Mayor Herbert C. Dyck, Council member; Greg Wilson, Jon Snapp, Kevin Williams, Meyler Gibbs.

Bids for the trash pump were reviewed. Greg Wilson moved to give Tim approval to purchase a trash pump up to \$1,600.00 using his discretion. Meyler Gibbs seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Bruna Implement: The yearly trade out of the skid loader as of August 1st is \$850.00. Jon Snapp moved to approve the trade with Brunas for \$850.00 for the skid loader. Kevin Williams seconded the motion. Motion carried.

John Cyr of NCRPC is interested in locating an antenna on top of the water tower for wireless internet in exchange give the City a free account. The equipment is \$1,250.00.

Thereupon Meyler Gibbs moved to allow John Cyr to put the equipment on the water tower in exchange for free hook up at no charge. Greg Wilson seconded the motion. Motion carried.
