

ADJOURNED MEETING; COUNCIL CHAMBERS; WASHINGTON, KANSAS; DATE: MARCH 21, 2005

The Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, met in Adjourned Session in the usual meeting place in said City on Monday, the twenty-first day of March, 2005, at 7:00 P.M. with the following members present: Mayor Travis Kier; Council Members Meyler Gibbs, Jon Snapp, Roxanne Schottel, Dawn Kramer and Kevin Williams.
