

ADJOURNED MEETING; COUNCIL CHAMBERS; WASHINGTON, KANSAS; DATE: JUNE 14, 2005

The Governing Body of the City of Washington, Kansas, met in Adjourned Session in the usual meeting place in said City on Tuesday, the fourteenth day of June, 2005, at 7:00 P.M. with the following members present: Council Members Dawn Kramer, Meyler Gibbs, Jon Snapp and Tom Dragastin.

ABSENT: Mayor Travis Kier; Council Member Roxanne Schottel.

ALSO PRESENT WERE: City Attorney Paul Monty.

In the absence of the Mayor, Council President Dawn Kramer called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

LAGOONS: City Attorney Paul Monty informed the Council that Larry Ditmars had not been in as of Council time to discuss the new lagoon irrigation contract and that he was still operating under the old contract.

LOTS: The Council asked that in the Housing Demolition Program the new contracts give a deadline to have the holes filled and lots leveled by a specified time period.

APPRAISAL: Council Member Meyler Gibbs made a motion to accept the appraisal bid of \$250 for the Kuhlman building, 110 East Second Street and the covered parking lot at Second and C Street from Mark Uhlik, The Realty Associates. Council Member Jon Snapp seconded the motion. Motion carried.

FIREWORKS: Council Member Jon Snapp moved to donate \$100 to the Fire Department towards the fireworks display. Council Member Tom Dragastin seconded the motion. Motion carried.

POOL: Council Member Jon Snapp moved to have a free swim at the pool from 1-5 p.m. July 4. Council Member Meyler Gibbs seconded the motion. Motion carried.

INDIVIDUAL COUNCIL COMMENTS: Council Member Jon Snapp visited about the EMS meeting with the County Commissioners and that they made no decision on the request to increase the EMS budget.

PERSONNEL POLICY: Members of the Council reviewed Article G-7 through Receipt & Acknowledgement of the Personnel Policy.
